Registration

Pre- squadding will be the normal again this season at bronzetrap@gmail.com

Non-squadded shooters may register up to 1:00 pm the day of the shoot.

The shoot starts at 9:00 a.m. and 9:30 at Wilmot

The fee is \$25.00 for 50 targets

The fee includes \$1.00 for hidden score purse, \$9.00 toward the League Fund for the purchase of trophies, pins and merchandise to be awarded at the Trophy Shoot, leaving \$15.00 for targets to the club holding the shoot that day.

The fee is waived for Junior shooters. A Junior shooter is 18 or younger at the first shoot. (*A female shooter 18 or under may declare either Junior or Lady but not both – league fee waived for junior only*)

Club Scoring 1st – 4 points

2nd – 3 points

3rd – 2 points

4th – 1 point

The Top seven (7) scores from each club will count for the team score

Shooting fees are as follows –

League Registration, Targets & Hidden Score \$ 25.00

Lewis (optional) \$ 5.00

The Lewis will be divided every 20 entries or major portion thereof, minimum of 4 classes, 50-30-20 High Gun.

Junior Shooters (18 years or under)

The League will reimburse the host Club for targets and the League will absorb the registration & hidden score fee for Juniors shooting targets only.

If a Junior shooter wishes to play the Lewis option then they must also pay for the targets, registration and hidden score fee.

Archery:

The RANGE OPEN sign at the 25Yd./100 Meter gate does not have to indicate that the range is OPEN when shooting archery.

The archery range is getting lot of use.
